

**Notification for Eligibility Test (ET) for
Post Qualification Course on Information Systems Audit (ISA)
on Saturday the 17th November, 2018**

Last Date for Online Form Submission 31st October, 2018 till 5:30 PM

1. The next Eligibility Test for ISA PQC is scheduled to be held on Saturday the 17th November, 2018 from 08:00 a.m. to 10.30 a.m.
2. The Eligibility Test is to be held in **offline mode**.
3. Status of candidates, who have completed ISA Professional Training from 1st April, 2018 to 30th September, 2018, would also be updated by 12th October, 2018. In case you do not find your status updated, kindly forward your request giving requisite details (ISA No, Membership No, Name, ISA PT Date and City) to isa@icai.in/isa1@icai.in, by 15th October, 2018.
4. Candidates desirous of taking this ISA ET have to submit the Online ISA ET Form that would be available at <https://pqc.icai.org> from 15th October, 2018 to 31st October, 2018.
5. ISA Eligibility Test November, 2018 will be conducted only under the New Syllabus. Members, who have completed PT Classes by 30th June, 2014 will be required to take exam under the new syllabus and the passing requirement in ISA ET would be 60% as applicable for all the candidates.
6. Candidates filling form B or C (2nd or subsequent attempt) have to ensure that their ISA ET Fee of Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only) would be paid through online that will be available on PQC Portal. Fill ET online Form and by selecting the Examination Center & submit the Form.
Note: Candidates appearing for the first time are not required to pay any fees and have to fill Form A
7. Applications received after the aforementioned last date would not be entertained under any circumstances.
8. Admit card for ISA ET November 2018 will be available from 12th November 2018 at <https://pqc.icai.org>.
9. Result of ISA Eligibility Test to be held on 17th November, 2018 would be announced by 5.00 P.M. on 28th November, 2018 Wednesday.
10. Members who have already cleared the ISA Eligibility Test, are not required to appear again.

ISA Eligibility Test Result Criteria:

The Digital Accounting and Assurance Board organized the last attempt of ISA Eligibility Test on 3rd December 2016 under the Old syllabus, now the ISA Eligibility Test is held under New syllabus only and the old syllabus is completely abolished.

Members who have attended the professional training classes under old syllabus but not cleared the ISA Eligibility Test have to clear the Eligibility Test under New Syllabus only.

As per the present scenario passing requirement in the ISA Eligibility Test is 60%. As there were no Module tests and Project work during the old syllabus, it was decided that for such candidate's eligibility test will be held for 120 marks however weightage shall be given out of 200 marks while declaring the result and the passing percentage will be 60%.

ISA Eligibility Test result will be declared under three categories as follows:

- (1) Old syllabus members who have appeared under new syllabus (Result is declared after giving weightage to 200 marks).
- (2) New syllabus members (whose Professional training classes started before February 2017), result is declared aggregating the Module Test, Project Work and Eligibility Test marks (Result is declared out of 200 marks).
- (3) Members who have cleared the module test and project work securing 60% marks (precondition for appearing in the Eligibility Test) (Applicable on Professional training classes started from February, 2017 and onwards) and appearing for the Eligibility Test (Result is declared out of 120 marks).
